Updates:

Steve Harvey reported that he has been able to redirect some funding toward the April 10 conference costs and the work of the Task Forces. He is reviewing resumes for a half-time assistant to help with the work of the Task Forces. He hopes to have this person in place by mid-January. On Dec. 3rd, he will present at a panel on the Statewide Plan for Higher Education. He said the plan for 2012-2020 is a 93-page document which has many connections to what the Consortium and Task Forces are trying to accomplish. He will report to the panel on what we are doing.

Task Force on Teacher Prep: Scott Payne reported that the group's initial document has turned into an action plan on three initiatives regarding teacher and leader prep. The group will continue to look at the action plan and move it forward.

Task Force on Common Core: Tony Day reported they continue to utilize and examine the role of Common Core Standards for the transition from High School to College. They are examining expectations and identifying gaps.
